

## Culturegrams

This resource is essentially the “go to” resource for the grade 3 social studies curriculum. This resource also supports the grade 2 social studies curriculum. Although it does not have specific information on Meteghan or Saskatoon it does include information about the provinces. This resource is also a great starting point for the grades 4 and 5 social studies curricula.

### Features

- Provinces edition supports for the grades 2 and 4 social studies curricula
- Kids Edition supports the grades 3 and 5 social studies curricula
- Read aloud feature in the top right-hand corner of every article
  - To customize the speed and colour of highlighting click on the cog image that appears when the slide out menu appears after play is pressed
- Provinces Edition - Along the top menu from the left-hand side access
  - Flag gallery
  - Recipes (two for every province)
  - Graphs and tables (pre-generated and customizable with multiple data sets included)
- Kids Edition – Along the top menu from the left-hand side
  - Photos (various parts of the countries)
  - Slideshow
  - Interviews (varies ages of interviewees – including children, adults and elderly)
  - Famous People (a listing of famous people and why they are famous)
  - Recipes (two from each country)
  - Flags
  - Graphs and Tables (pre-generated Canada In Focus section devoted to articles about significant Canadian people, places and history)
- Content divided into smaller sections along the left-hand side for ease of access
- Kids Edition – content also found along the right-hand side of article including
  - Distance calculator
  - World time
  - Teaching activities
  - Curriculum standards (Alberta not available)
