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## TO START USING MUZZY BBC IN YOUR CLASSROOM, FOLLOW THESE STEPS:

1. Choose the language you want to teach.
2. Click on the first unit and open the e-book in the center of the screen. This is a short version of The Big Muzzy Story and will help students understand the dialog.
3. Now click on Video Story, then select Story. You have the option of watching the story in your students' native language (to learn the script), or in the target language for an immersive experience.
4. Allow students to watch over and over, as repetition is key to learning.
5. Explore the other tabs in this unit or back out and start your students with games to reinforce what they learned by watching the video.
6. Non-reading children can play the games with the headphone icon. Children who read can experience the games with the book icon. The degree of difficulty is indicated with a plus sign.

Additional information, including a list of all words and concepts taught in MUZZY BBC, can be found by clicking on the life saver icon on the screen where you select the Part.

The script of the video for each unit is available. After selecting the Part, click on the printer icon at the bottom of the screen, then click on Video Story Book.
